The Janis Faith Steingruber Student Travel Award supports either a graduate or undergraduate anthropology student in anthropology to participate in archaeological digs and field work. The award may also provide assistance to students participating in a scientific meeting.

APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 17, 2023 BY 5:00 P.M.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The applicant must be a graduate or undergraduate student in good standing and majoring in anthropology at the University of Georgia.

PROPOSAL FORMAT

Adherence to the following proposal format is mandatory. Those applications not following the format will not be considered for review. Please note the limits on length for each section.

- Page 1 - Application Cover Sheet
- Pages 2-3
 - Summary of the research objectives and field work, or purpose in participating in a scientific meeting. (If attending a scientific meeting, include the accepted abstract with your application.)
 - Discussion of methods, procedures, and expected results
 - Budget. Give details of costs for supplies, transportation, lodging, and other expenses directly related to the field project or scientific meeting noting any funding already received for the project. **(Please make sure your expenses are allowable by UGA.)**
 - Expected schedule for completion of the field work and the overall project or attending the meeting
- Pages 4-x
 - Unofficial transcript. Applicants may obtain their unofficial transcript from Athena.

The proposal should be in twelve-point type, single-spaced, and with one-inch margins. Students applying for multiple departmental awards need only submit one proposal as long as it is clear in the research summary why the proposed research qualifies for each award.

Submit the proposal to anthro@uga.edu by January 17, 2023 at 5:00pm. Applications will be reviewed by the departmental awards committee, which will select finalists on the basis of proposal quality and an applicant's academic performance and professional promise. The departmental awards committee and department head reserve the right to determine the dollar amount awarded.
